COURSE INFORMATION

NFPA 1021 Fire Officer I Course meets Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP), State Firemen's & Fire Marshals' Assn. (SFFMA) and ProBoard (NBFSPQ) certification requirements.

Rural Volunteer Fire Department (VFD) Assistance Program (HB 2604)

- ♦ Training tuition grants under this program will be provided up to a maximum of \$125 per day, not to exceed \$650 per trainee per school.
- ♦ Training tuition grants are limited to a maximum of \$6,250 per department per school.
- ♦ The maximum amount of Training Tuition assistance a department may receive in a fiscal year (September through August) is \$12,500.

Texas Intrastate Fire Mutual Aid System (TIFMAS)

- ♦ Training Tuition grants under this program will be provided up to a maximum of \$125 per day, not to exceed \$650 per trainee per school.
- ♦ Training tuition grants are limited to a maximum of \$6,250 per department per school.
- ♦ The maximum amount of Training Tuition assistance a department may receive in a fiscal year (September through August) is \$12,500.
